According to Art. 108 from the Constitution, republished, to art. 2 from Urgenct Government Ordinance no. 120/2003 regarding the approval of the initiation by RNCMNR of one - source negotiation procedures with the company Bechtel International Inc., regarding the finalization of the design, build and financing contract for Brasov-Cluj –Bors Motorway, and of art. 70 from law no. 141/1997 regarding the Romanian Customs Code, with subsequent modifications and attachements, the Romanian Government adopts the following decision.

Art 1. – The Contract for designing and building the Brasov-Cluj-Bors Motorway is hereby approved, under the form negotiated in legal conditions by RNCMNR and Bechtel International Inc., specified in the annex which is included in the present decision.

Art. 2 - RNCMNR is delegated to sign the contract for design and construction of Brasov-Cluj-Bors Motorway with the investor selected according to Government Ordinance no. 120/2003.

Art. 3 - The amounts relating to the payments of customs duties for importing technological equipment, machinery and gear used by the contractor for the development of the contract stipulated in art. 1 shall be paid from the national budget, through the budget allocated to the Ministry of Transports, Constructions and Tourism, through RNCMNR.

Art. 4 – The Ministry of Transports, Constructions and Tourism will put in their best efforts for obtaining the approvals, permits and authorizations required for developing the contract mentioned in Art. 1.
